Distribution of Marks & modified Question Pattern of CBCS Based Six-Semester Degree Programme of B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL AND HONOURS) COURSES

(Effective from Second Semester 2017-2018 Session onwards)

A. For the courses (GENERAL & HONOURS PROGRAMME) of 100 marks (For CC, DSC, DSE, SEC & GE courses) without practical component other than AECC (All Language subjects), MIL (All Language subjects) and Compulsory English:

Group	Type of Question	Mark distribution
Group-A	Objective Type Questions: There must be total 20 questions with answer choice options having 1 mark each covering the total syllabus. All the questions are compulsory.	1 x 20 = 20
Group-B	Short Questions: From every unit there must be 2 alternative questions of 3 marks each and in total 8 questions from the total 4 units. Students have to answer 4 questions taking 1 question from each unit.	3 x 4 = 12
Group-C	Broad / Descriptive Questions: From every unit there must be 2 alternative questions of 12 marks each and in total 8 questions from the total 4 units. The total 12 marks for a question may be split into several parts. Students have to answer 4 questions taking 1 question from each unit.	12 x 4 = 48
	Internal Assessment	20
	Total for each paper	100

*The Objective Type Questions, Short type and Broad / Descriptive Questions will be set covering all the units of the course/paper.

B. For the courses (GENERAL & HONOURS PROGRAMME) of 100 marks (For CC, DSC, DSE, SEC & GE courses) with practical component:

Group	Type of Question	Mark distribution
Group-A	Short Questions: From every unit there must be 2 questions of 2 marks each and in total 8 questions from the total 4 units. Students have to answer 6 questions out of 8 questions.	2 x 6 = 12
Group-B	Broad / Descriptive Questions: From every unit there must be 2 alternative questions of 12 marks each and in total 8 questions from the total 4 units. The total 12 mark for a question may be split into several parts but no question should comprise greater than 5 marks. Students have to answer 4 questions taking 1 question from each unit.	12 x 4 = 48
	Internal Assessment	10
	Practical	30
	Total for each paper	100

*The Short type and Broad / Descriptive Questions will be set covering all the units of the course/paper.

C. For **Environmental Science (AECC course)** for **(GENERAL & HONOURS PROGRAMME)** of 100 marks without practical component:

Type of Question	Mark distribution
Multiple Choice Questions: Total 80 question having 1 mark each. All the questions are compulsory. From every unit there must be 20 questions.	1 x 80 = 80
Internal Assessment	20
Total for each paper	100

*The MCQ type of questions will be set covering all the units of the course/paper.


D. For **AECC (All Language subjects), MIL (All Language subjects) and Compulsory English** for 100 marks without practical component:

Group	Type of Question	Mark distribution
Group-A	Objective Type Questions: Total 40 questions with answer choice options having 1 mark each. All the questions are compulsory. From every unit there must be 10 questions.	1 x 40 = 40
Group-B	Broad / Descriptive Questions: From every unit there must be 2 alternative questions of 10 marks each and in total 8 questions from the total 4 units. <i>The total 10 mark for a question may be split into several parts but no question should comprise greater than 5 marks.</i> Students have to answer 4 questions taking 1 question from each unit.	10 x 4 = 40
	Internal Assessment	20
	Total for each paper	100

*The Objective Type Questions and Broad / Descriptive Questions will be set covering all the units of the course/paper.
