An interview with Ms. Rageswari Dhar, a Doodle artist of Tripura

1. What is the name of this art festival?
Ans: Dot-a-Matism

2. Would you please explain what is dot-a-matism?
Ans: Dot-a-Matism is an festival in Tripura that provides the artist to show their articulated thoughts in the form of art by using DOT, as a medium. It comes in 2D form where it all starts. The theme of the event is mostly surrealism, both, care of life and handling the beauty of creativity. The festival features a variety of artistic disciplines, including sculpture, installations, and photography. Artists from all over Tripura and the surrounding region are participating.

3. When did you start gaining interest in painting?
Ans: At the age of 5.

4. Can you remember any incident that drew your interest in painting?
Ans: When I was a kid I was fond of color & chalk. I was still a shy adolescent. Everyone I came to then as an artist I used to ask my art teacher “why is this sky blue?” and why ever I paint it pink, orange, yellow, and all teacher give me the freedom to paint my own sky according to my will and imagination my artwork always. Working shows the necessary team, when I remember this particular incident, I begin to exhibit these artworks in the month, each time. Today, I’m painting my own sky, with colors I never imagined. Sky’s the limit I guess, and getting the chance to paint my own sky is a blessing, I believe, overall.

5. Who is your inspiration as a painter?
Ans: My cousin brother, Sri Agnita Datta. He used to paint with acrylic on Canvas.

6. Are your parents engaged in any cultural activity?
Ans: Not really so but they appreciate my interest in art. They encourage me to do cultural activity that goes around the state.

7. Who are your Co-organizers?

Ans: We are five. Besides me, there is a doctor, a teacher, a Chartered Accountant. Other three are engineers. Bidyut Dasgupta, Manojkanta Mishra and Anindya Ghosh.

8. Who is your teacher in developing your skill in painting?
Ans: I am.

9. What is the genre of your painting?
Ans: Doodle Art, surrealist Art.

10. Please tell us something about this genre.
Ans: Doodle Art is a form of art that can have either representational meaning or may just be composed of random and abstract lines, or shapes, generally without ever lifting the drawing, as it is usually called a doodle. People often make doodles while their hands are inactive and thinking about other things. In this way, doodles are usually beautiful works of art with content and meaning.

11. How do you exhibit your artwork within Agartala art to take it outside the capital to other parts of the state?
Ans: I am an organizer, an exhibitor. I do have a desire to present my art on a national/international level. Agartala is my home town and people residing here have little knowledge about art and its display.

12. Besides painting, what else are you doing?
Ans: Besides painting, I am pursuing a Masters in English Literature. I have an interest in poetry, narratives. I write poetry as well.

13. Who are you doing a Masters in English without doing any course on it?
Ans: I literature is art. Art is literature. I do have an interest in literature. English literature is diverse and pursuing this course safe by side is kinda helpful for me. It allows me to think beyond my imagination, studying literature helps me to understand things deeply. Studying literature my thought capacity helps me to create art with detailed imagination.

14. What is your next plan, to host your exhibition within Agartala art to take it outside the capital to other parts of the state?
Ans: I am an organizer, an exhibitor. I do have a desire to present my art on a national/international level. Agartala is my home town and people residing here have little knowledge about art and its display.

Ans: Financially & mostly my parents are very supportive. But I believe in spending my own money and I kinda avoid taking money from my parents.

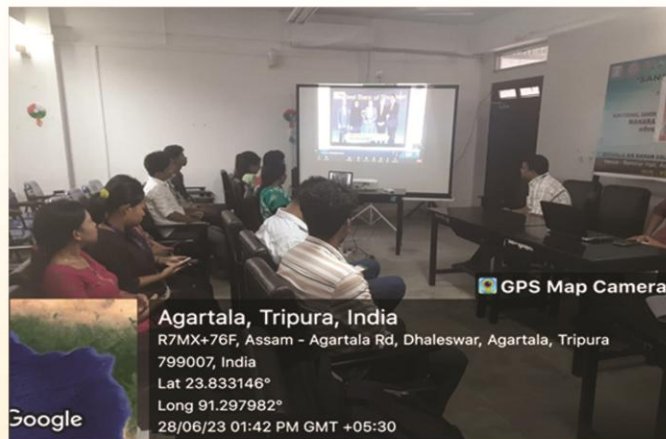
Centre of Non-Formal Sanskrit Education

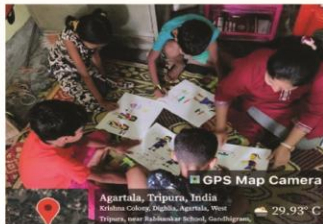

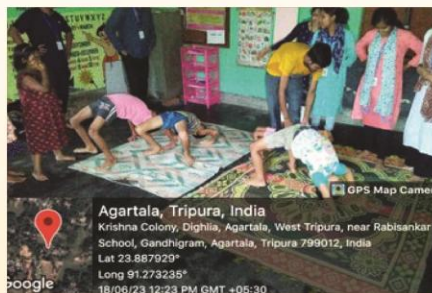
