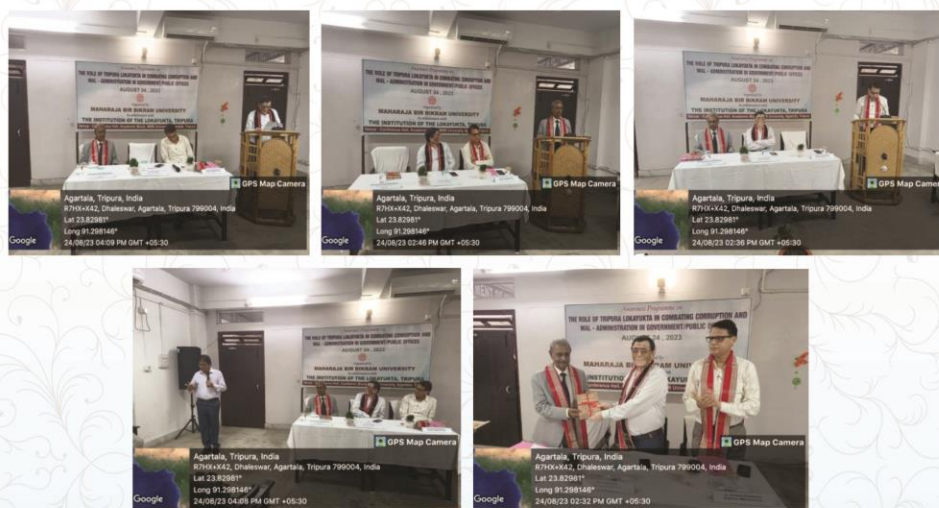

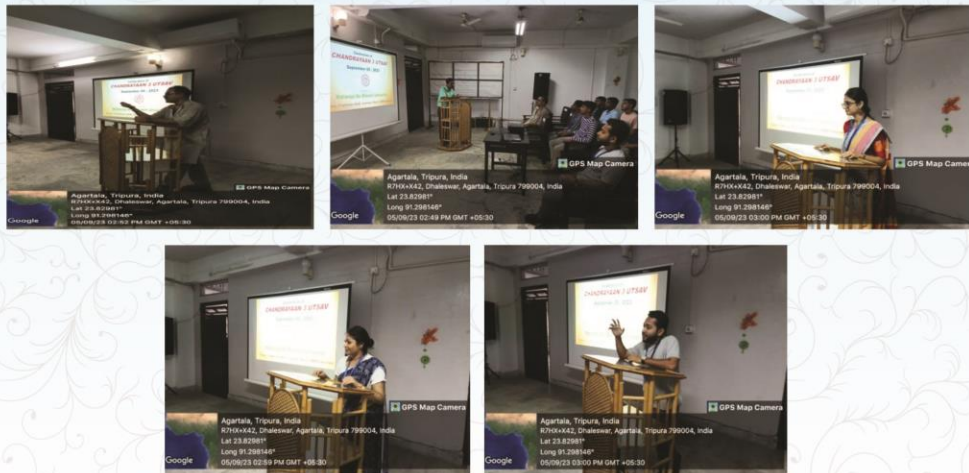

In his speech Dr. Sumanta Chakrabarti discussed on the theme of the World Earth Day 2023, that is “Invest in our Planet”. He said that to save our Green Planet, we must invest in proper education. Without proper education it will be extremely difficult to save our Earth. Today due to urbanization, uncontrolled use of plastic products, industry augmented pollution has put the environmental diversity in front of existential crisis. This irreversible damage to our ecosystem can only be reverted with proper awareness. He has informed that the present Earth Overshoot Day has been estimated to fall in the month of July. He also highlighted the destructive effects of war and genocide on the environment. According to Prof. Dasgupta, women play an important role in the conservation of our environment. Therefore, we must invest in our planet to bring peace and empower women, for the sake of the existence of our beloved planet. The Chief Guest of this program, Prof. Purnendu Kanti Das put emphasis on the role of young generation in saving our planet. The youths are the flag bearers of the future and they have to play a pivotal role to save the Earth. Therefore, we must invest in all round development of the aspiring young generation so that they become aware and sensitive towards saving the planet. 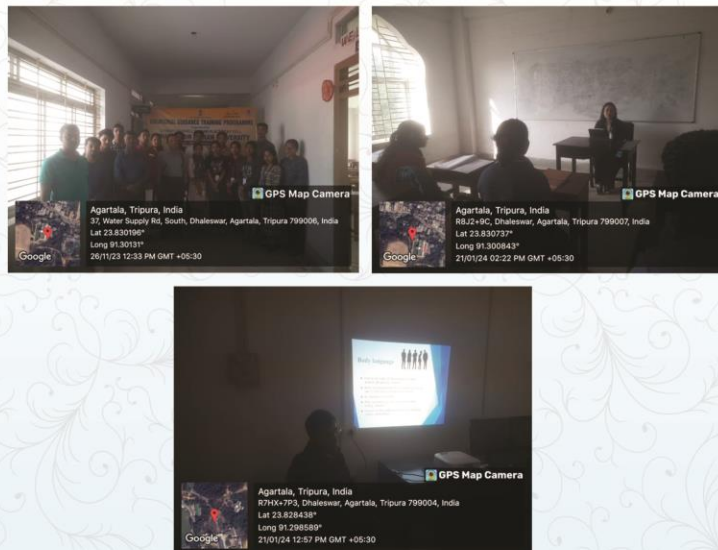


Career Counselling and Placement Cell
