NAAC Accreditation of MBB University

NAAC accreditation is a crucial step in academic journey of an institute of higher education. Maharaja Bir Bikram University has been taking preparation for its NAAC accreditation since its inception despite its limited physical and human resource infrastructure. The University submitted its Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) on December 28, 2023. Following its acceptance by NAAC office on January 18, 2024, the SSR was submitted on February 28, 2024. The NAAC office conducted online Students' Satisfaction Survey and subsequently approved the submitted SSR on May 04, 2024. As part of the NAAC accreditation process, the University also submitted Data Validation and Verification (DVV) with required clarification. The NAAC Peer Team visited MBB University during September 10 to 12, 2024 for physical verification and examination of information furnished by MBB University in its SSR. The NAAC Peer Team included five members with Prof. Sailesh Zala and Prof. Sanjay Singh Baghel as the Chairperson and Member Coordinator of the team respectively. Prof. Devesh Nigam, Prof. Francis A P Akralak and Prof. Pradipta Kumar Behera were the other three members of the team. The NAAC was pleased to declare MBB University, College Tilla, Agartala accredited with CGPA of 2.28 on four-point scale at B Grade.

Department of English

About the Department:

The Department of English was established in the year 2016 with syllabus prepared in accordance with the CBCS pattern to provide more flexibility to the students in selecting the courses. Since its inception, it has grown steadily with increasing numbers of students taking admission each year, both within and outside the state. The Syllabus incorporates Poetry, Drama, Literary Theory and Criticism, European Literature in Translation, American Literature, Women's Writing, Popular Fiction, Indian Writing in English, Post-colonial Literature, Dalit Literature, Indian Aesthetics etc. The Department also offers a Compulsory Elective Course on Communication Skills in English for all the Post-Graduate Departments of the University to enhance their speaking and writing skills in English language. It encourages the students in reading texts critically through multiple theoretical perspective and to inculcate knowledge of literary and cultural studies. The Department aims to develop the student's perception of the richness of English Literature, enhance the critical mind and imaginations through the study of literary texts. The Department has successfully organized International and National conferences, seminars etc. in core and interdisciplinary areas of the subject with participation of academicians, policy makers and scholars from various higher educational institutions. The Department introduced the Ph. D Programme from the academic session 2021-2022.

Activities of the Department:

The Department of English, Maharaja Bir Bikram University organized successfully a two-day National Seminar on "Philosophical Foundation of Language, Literature and Culture in Northeast India" on November 14-15, 2024. The Seminar was sponsored by Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR), Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi. The inaugural session of the seminar was held on November 14, 2024 in the Dhalai Hall, Academic Block, MBB University.

The seminar was inaugurated by Shri Rajib Bhattacharjee, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Rajya Sabha, Government of India as the Chief Guest. In his address he expressed the importance of fostering social cohesion through cultural exchange. He acknowledged and addressed the ongoing challenges in preserving the cultural unity of the North East India. He also placed the importance of unity in the North East amidst attempts to divide the region based on religion, language, and tribe. Prof Vijay Kumar Karn, Department of Sanskrit, Nava Nalanda Mahavihara emphasized the "science of the soul" urging the audience to view the world with a clear and unbiased perspective. He underscored the need to understand Indian literature (Sahitya) and philosophy, Prof. Prasenjit Biswas, Department of Philosophy, Northeastern Hill

University, Shillong delivered the Key-note address with a unique perspective on the philosophical traditions of the North East India. Emphasizing a deeper understanding of North East India's culture, he advocated for a trans-disciplinary approach that respects diversity and distinctiveness of each tribe free from political influences. His work on medicinal herbs and geological marvels, further underscored NE's ecological and cultural wealth. Dr. Sumanta Chakrabarti, Registrar, MBB University in his address highlighted the urgent need for fostering further integration of the Northeast India in terms of language and cultural implicitly. Prof. Satyadeo Poddar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, MBB University analyzed the lack of extensive research on language, culture and literature on Northeast India as unique identity and urged for theorizing it to understand the richness of the North East India's language, literature and culture. In this two-day seminar many Professors and Academicians from different Universities like North Eastern Hill University, Nava Nalanda Mahavihara, Assam University, Gauhati University etc. and Colleges of Northeast India participated and presented their papers. More than 150 participants participated in the seminar.

Ms. Rebeka Debbarma, Assistant Professor, Department of English, MBB University delivered the welcome address in the inaugural session and vote of thanks in the valedictory session. Dr. Jhuma Majumder, Assistant Professor & In-Charge, Department of English, MBB University delivered the vote of thanks in the inaugural session.

The Department also organised one special lecture on “The Aesthetics of the Margin (al) : Texts and Paratexts” on July 08, 2024.

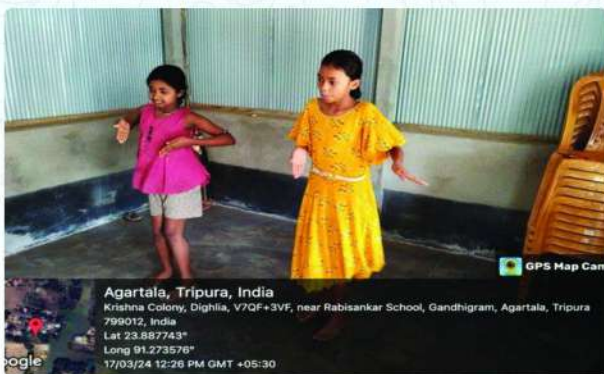

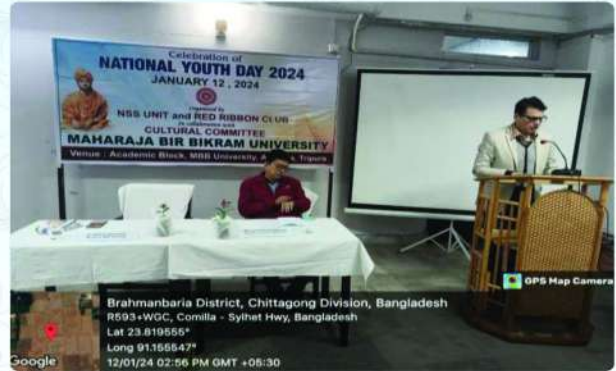

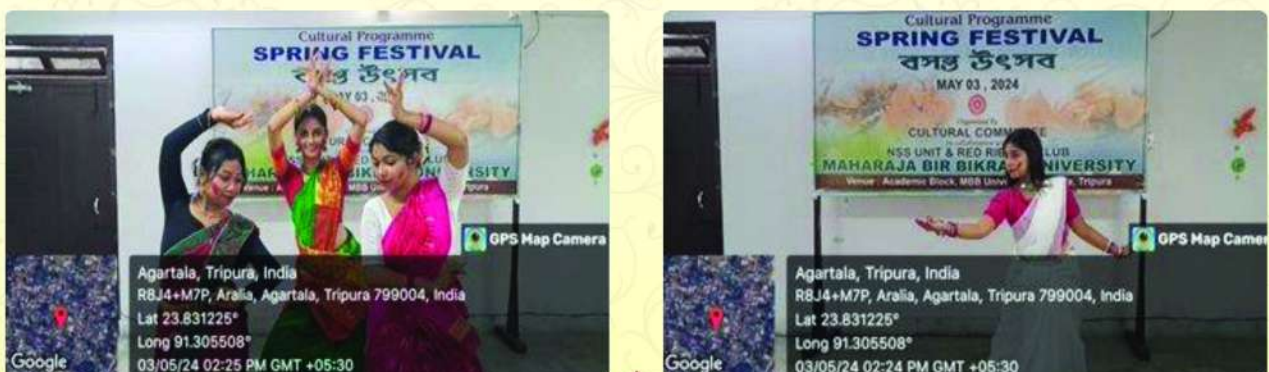

Day 5: May 03, 2024

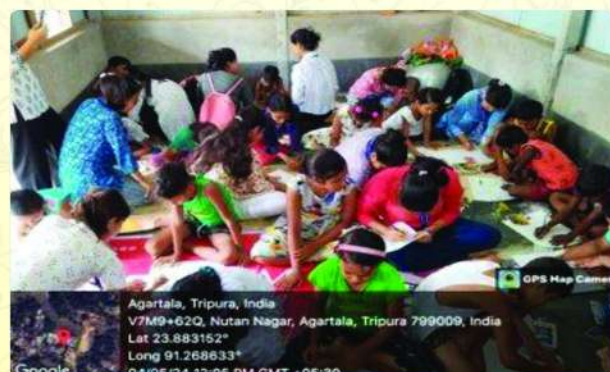
