MAHARAJA BIR BIKRAM UNIVERSITY: A PROFILE

Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya was a visionary king. At the age of 30 in the year 1937 he had a dream for an institution which would be not only a college, but an “**Abode of Learning**”. His dream of an “**Abode of Learning**” started by the process of acquiring **234 acres** of land in 1937 consisting of hillocks, lakes and plain fields in this College tilla, where we assemble today and Maharaja called the whole scheme as **Vidyapattan**.

Maharaja's plan of **Vidyapattan** was not only to have a college, but also a technical school, a school of physical culture, painting, music & other schools, hospital, hostels, theatre hall including one **Rural University** in the campus. Maharaja Bir Bikram College is the first college in the princely state of Tripura. It started its maiden journey on **September 29, 1947** and it took about 68 years to turn it into a reality to establish the Maharaja Bir Bikram University in 2015. The present area of this **Vidyapattan** consisting of MBB University and three affiliated colleges namely Maharaja Bir Bikram College, Bir Bikram Memorial College and Tripura Government Law College is about **72 acres** of land.

To cater the needs of higher education of the graduated students, the Government of Tripura decided to establish a public funded State University in the memory of the last king of Tripura, 'Maharaja BirBikram Kishore Manikya' and accordingly **Maharaja Bir Bikram University** was established by the MBB University Act, 2015 of the Tripura Legislative Assembly. The Act received the assent of the Honourable Governor on 15.09.2015 (The Tripura Act No. 6 of 2015), which came into effect on 1st Day of November, 2015.

Objectives:

The different Departments of the University are providing teaching and extension works to achieve the objectives of the University in the line of Ideas, Imagination and Innovation. Students from Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes of this region generally need extra attention. Thirty one percent (31%) of seats of all courses offered by the University are reserved for the students belonging to scheduled tribes and seventeen percent (17%) for students belonging to scheduled castes. The courses at under graduate and post graduate levels have their own thrust areas broadly in consonance with the institutional goals and as well as the local/ national/ regional/ global needs of the time. The syllabi of different programmes have a component relating to the people, administration, science and literature of the hilly areas of North Eastern Region of India.

Vision:

Maharaja Bir Bikram University is a public institution dedicated to serving the people of Tripura in particular and the people of the entire Northeast India in general. The University is working towards realization of the dream of Maharaja Bir Bikram Manikya Bahadur to make it an '**Abode of Learning**'. To fulfill this vision, along with newly emerged challenges in the society, the University also envisions-

1. To promote world citizenry, disseminate and advance knowledge in interdisciplinary studies and research, developing critical thoughts and creativity.
2. To preserve and promote multicultural heritages of India by respecting rights and dignities of all.
3. To give special emphasis on the pursuit of inclusive achievement and academic excellence with a motto of becoming “good human being”.

Mission:

Established in 2016, MBB University is a new higher educational institution. It wishes to grow further as a responsible learning community. The University inspires the student community and other individuals to explore widely, think critically, communicate clearly, and connect ideas creatively to address our most challenging needs, problems and questions in diverse field of studies. Being the highest and noblest seat of learning, the mission of the University is the preservation, advancement, and dissemination of knowledge by providing effective leadership in guiding and promoting educational opportunities and research works in various fields. Lastly, the University endeavours to channelize its mission for academic and administrative commitment for promoting communal harmony, saving environmental stakes and exploring opportunities for the marginalized section of society.

At present the University has 7 Departments and offers 10 programmes which include Under Graduate and Post Graduate Programmes. Besides these, the University also offers Ph.D Programme in 4 subjects.

The MBB University provides academic support to 3 affiliated Degree Colleges in the State by way of formulating the curricula, supervising academic programmes and conducting examinations.

The University has Centre for Development of Communication Skills and Centre for Coaching of NET, UPSC, TPSC, Banking & other competitive examinations for students.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION& IMPORTANT RULES:

Registration:

After admission, a student shall have to fill up an online registration form. After filling up the registration form, a student shall have to submit the print copy of the filled in form duly forwarded by the concerned HoD/In-Charge along with the original migration certificate within the stipulated date and time as notified by MBB University. Students from the colleges affiliated to MBB University shall have to fill up the online registration form but they have to submit the photocopy of their registration certificate along with the filled in registration form.

Curriculum:

Each Post Graduate programme of the University is comprised of a set of Courses, some of which are Core, Compulsory and others are Elective. Elective Courses are two types-1) Discipline Specific Electives (DSE) and 2) Open Electives (OE). Open Elective Course(s) which is to be chosen by the students from other Departments or from SWAYAM.

The University follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for all its academic programmes.

Evaluation System:

Students are evaluated through a continuous comprehensive evaluation system under which a student is evaluated through a number of written tests, assignments, seminars spread over the entire semester. Each Department conducts Internal Assessments (30%) which comprises of written tests/assignments/seminars/book review etc. At the end of the Semester, the Controller of Examinations conducts the Semester End Examination (70%). Credit Points are given on the basis of marks secured by the candidate taking together the marks of Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination.

STUDENTS' LIFE AT MBBU

MBB University organises cultural and other activities round the year, which provide opportunities for students to grow them in their own fields of choice. Some of the major activities are-

Annual Cultural Programme:

A Cultural Committee of the University has been constituted to promote cultural activities among students of the University and to encourage students to participate in various cultural events. The Annual Cultural Programme of MBB University is generally organised in the month of November. Students can participate in Group as well as Individual events. Some of the major events are songs, dances, recitations, drama etc.

Observance of Kokborok Day:

The University observes Kokborok Day on 19th January every year. On this day, the University organises special lectures from eminent personalities of Tripura and events on indigenous culture and languages with active participation of students.

Hobby Clubs:

There are altogether six Clubs with the initiative of Students and Coordinated by Faculty Members such as i) Debate Club, ii) Adventure Club, iii) Innovation Club, iv) Movie & Photography Club, v) Music & Drama Club, vi) Quiz Club, vii) Eco Club, viii) Science Club

NSS:

National Service Scheme in MBB University intends to involve students in nation building process. The NSS unit organises *Swach Bharat Abhiyan*, Voluntary Blood Donation, Eye Donation camps at regular intervals. The University has also adopted one village, Dighalia Gram Panchayat as part of its community service engagement activities.

Days of Importance and Remembrance:

The students of the University also organises different events and observes the Independence Day, Republic Day, National Science Day, International Mother Tongue Day, International Library Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Birthday of Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya Bahadur, National Youth Day, World AIDS Day, World Environment Day, International Women's Day etc. with active participation.

Youth Red Cross (YRC) Sub-Committee:

The University has constituted A State Level Youth Red Cross (YRC) Sub-Committee.

Red Ribbon Club:

MBB University has constituted a Red Ribbon Club to raise awareness against HIV/AIDS & Injecting Drug use.

Consumer Club:

MBB University has constituted a Consumer Club to promote consumer awareness by conduction various consumer awareness programs.

TEACHING AND LEARNING FACILITIES

Library:

The University has a Library with an increasing number in the collection of books, periodicals, journals and e-resources. The Library has CCTV surveillance system for safety of library materials. The library has a diverse collection of more than five thousand books, periodicals etc. The collection of library covers the latest information resources on all areas of Social Science, Humanities & Science. MBB University has registered in INFLIBNET for providing e-books/e-journals to students, research scholars and faculties. The Library of the University remains open from 10.00 AM to 05.30 PM everyday.

Computer Lab:

The University has a Computer Lab. All the Computers are equipped with Soft wares like C++, KOHA etc. for use of the students of the University.

RESERVATION POLICY:

In case of admission, reservation policy of the Government of Tripura will be strictly followed.
